ITINERARY OVERVIEW

Day 1 – Day 2

Victoria Falls Safari Suites, Victoria Falls sunset cruise, Flying Fox over the gorge, Victoria Falls walking tour, Livingstone Island.

2 nights

Day 3

Chobe Game Lodge, Chobe Safari

1 night

Day 4 – Day 6

Camp Okavango, Okavango Delta activities like Mokoros, motor boat activities, fishing, bird watching and nature walks

3 nights

Day 7 – Day 10

Xakanaxa Camp, Okavango Delta Activities like game drives, boat activities, bird watchers and nature walks

DAY 1:

On arrival in Victoria Falls, you will be met by your driver-guide and transferred to The Victoria Falls Safari Suites.
(Transfer is approximately 30 minutes in duration)

On arrival at the hotel, proceed with check in formalities.

You will be collected from the hotel reception and transferred to Gorge Cafe where you will enjoy a **Flying fox**. Imagine taking a running jump into thin air over the chasm, soaring horizontally through the air over the turmoil of the Zambezi below. The gorge at this point is 200 meters wide and 120 meters deep. This is a great appetizer before you try the Zip Line and Gorge Swing.

You will be transferred back to your hotel after your activity.

You will be met by your driver-guide and transferred to the jetty for your sunset cruise aboard **The Victoria**. Take a river safari downstream towards the smoke that thunders, whilst lounging in comfort. Indulge in ultimate comfort aboard The Victoria, our queen of the fleet. Designed to mirror the style and sophistication of Old English safari, relax while a Victoria Falls Hotel chef prepares sushi and other gourmet canapés.

Transfer to your hotel after your cruise. Spend the evening at leisure.

DAY 2:

Enjoy breakfast at the hotel.

You will be met by your driver-guide in the hotel reception and depart on your **Private Tour of the Falls Zimbabwe & Zambia.**

(Ponchos and bottles water will be provided)

Please remember that you will be crossing from Zimbabwe into Zambia, therefore please remember your passports.

Lunch will be served at the Falls Resort.

Enjoy your afternoon Livingstone Island tour.

Here's an infinity pool like no other! One of the most astounding natural pools to be found anywhere, Devil's Pool has a reputation for attracting thrill-seekers from the far corners of the earth. Guided tours to Livingstone Island have a 100% safety record and our guides will be with you at all times to offer a hand, share fun facts, or simply take photographic evidence to bring home to the family. This includes afternoon high-tea and drinks.

Transfer back to your hotel after your island tour

Enjoy a farewell African Feast at The Boma.

You will transfer back to your hotel after dinner.

DAY 3:

Enjoy breakfast at the hotel and check-out. *Settle your extras account.*

You will be met by your driver, for your onward transfer to Kasane. *(Transfer is approximately 90 minutes in duration)*

On arrival in Kasane, you will be met by a lodge representative and transferred to Chobe Game Lodge. *(Transfer is approximately 20 minutes in duration)*

On arrival, you will be assisted with check in formalities followed by lunch.

Picturesquely situated 100 km west of the Victoria Falls, overlooking the Chobe River and the Caprivi floodplains, the iconic **Chobe Game Lodge** is the only permanent safari lodge within the Chobe National Park. The lodge accommodates up to 94 guests in absolute luxury. Rooms are river-facing, and include minibars, en-suite bathrooms, tea and coffee making facilities as well as private terraces. In addition, four exclusive suites have their own plunge pools and separate lounges. Other facilities include a fully equipped conference room seating up to 90 people, broadband internet, billiards, library, gym, beauty salon, a stylish cigar bar overlooking the Chobe River, a large terraced swimming pool and riverside boma area. All safari activities are tailored to suit individual requirements. Game drives, game viewing by small boats with a maximum capacity of twelve guests, sunset cruises along the Chobe River and after-dinner stargazing are offered.

DAY 4:

You will be advised by lodge management, of your exact departure time on the evening of day 3.

Guests will enjoy an early morning game activity followed by breakfast.

Proceed with check out formalities and transfer to Kasane Airport, for your onward scheduled light aircraft from **KASANE AIRPORT** to **CAMP OKAVANGO**. **Approximately a 90 minute scheduled light aircraft flight / Luggage restriction is 20kg's per person in soft bags**

On arrival at the airstrip, meet your camp representative and transfer to camp. Proceed to with check in formalities, before enjoying brunch. **Botswana's magnificent Okavango Delta situated within the heart of the newly declared World Heritage site, is the world's largest inland delta**, and is a maze of deep lagoons, large lakes and hidden, meandering channels. During the annual flood season the Delta covers a vast area of over 16 000 km² before shrinking to less than 9 000 km² in the dry season. Trapped in a basin of parched Kalahari Desert sand, the fresh water oasis attracts wildlife that depends on the permanent waters of this unique environment. **Camp Okavango**, a unique and exclusive African safari camp is situated on the remote Nxabaga Island. This hidden treasure, in the heart of the permanent Okavango Delta, assures its guests of an unparalleled year-round water wilderness experience.

DAY 7:

Proceed with check out formalities and transfer to the airstrip, for your onward scheduled light aircraft from **CAMP OKAVANGO** to **XAKANAXA CAMP**. ***Approximately a 20 minute scheduled light aircraft flight / Luggage restriction is 20kg's per person in soft bags***

On arrival at the airstrip, meet you camp representative and transfer to camp. Proceed to with check in formalities, before enjoying brunch.

The prime location of Camp Xakanaxa (pronounced Ka-ka-na-ka) on the banks of the Khwai River on the Xakanaxa Lagoon, in the heart of the Moremi Game Reserve, makes it one of the very few safari camps that offers guests an authentic, year-round Okavango Delta land and water safari experience. The ancient riverine forests, open savannah, serpentine channels and seasonal floodplains that surround the camp make for a varied habitat of exceptional fauna and flora.
