

DAY 1:

Arrive at Cape Town (CPT) International Airport on flight **ET 847** and clear immigration and customs.

Proceed to the arrivals hall where you will be met by a Royal African Discoveries representative who will hand over your documentation and assist you to your vehicle.

Transfer to your hotel.

Upon arrival at your hotel check-in.

(Please note that standard check-in time is at 14:00. Early check-in can be requested however it is at the discretion of the hotel and not guaranteed).

Spend the balance of the day at leisure.

Dinner is served at the Flag Ship restaurant of the Erinvale Estate Hotel, Seventeen07.

DAY 2:

Enjoy breakfast at the hotel.

08:30

You will be met in the reception area of your hotel by your driver-guide for a **Private Full Day Cape Peninsula Tour**. Travel at a pace that allows you to explore the beauty of the Cape Peninsula. Depart for the Cape of Good Hope Nature Reserve **along one of South Africa's most scenic routes**, passing through Hout Bay. Embark on a cruise to Seal Island, to view seals and sea birds at Duiker Island (weather permitting). During summer, several thousand Cape Fur Seals – along with the rare Black Cormorant – lollop leisurely among the kelp beds.

Enjoy a **Motorbike Sidecar Experience** for your transfer to lunch (weather permitting). Meet your driver at your pick-up address (Hout Bay Harbour) where you will complete indemnities and then suit up in our cool riding gear. Travel via Chapmans Peak and enjoy the breath taking views en-route to Fishhoek.

Lunch is served at the Fishhoek Galley Restaurant.

Proceed with your driver-guide in your **Private vehicle for the duration of today's tour**.

Visit the penguin colony at Boulders Beach.

Continue to the Cape of Good Hope Nature Reserve. Indigenous fauna and flora are conserved in this priceless wilderness area. The scenery en route to Cape Point, at the South Western tip of the reserve, is particularly lovely in spring when wildflowers carpet the landscape. The new lighthouse – the most powerful in the world – beams an electric light of 19 million candle power across the ocean. Ascend to the top by Funicular.

Dinner is served at the Oak Terrace Restaurant (adjacent to your hotel – no dinner transfer required).

Return to your hotel and spend the balance of your evening at leisure.

DAY 3:

Enjoy breakfast at the hotel.

08:30 You will be met by your driver-guide for your **Private Full Days Touring**.

Ascend Table Mountain for unforgettable sweeping views (weather permitting).

Return to the city passing through the Malay Quarter. Drive past the Castle, Houses of Parliament and the Company Gardens. Travel to Sea Point and Camp's Bay for scenic ocean vistas.

Visit Groot Constantia Wine estate for wine tasting and lunch.

Constantia was one of the first wine-producing areas of the Western Cape, and Groot Constantia is one of the first and finest examples of Cape Dutch architecture.

The homestead is exquisitely furnished with antiques.

Lunch is served at Jonkerhuis Constantia Eatery.

Visit the Victoria and Alfred Waterfront for some leisure time.

As the Sun Sets on the vibrant city, board the giant observation wheel that offers a 360 degree panoramic view of Cape Town.

Dinner is served at a local Indian restaurant Favor 8.

Return to your hotel and spend the balance of the evening at leisure.

DAY 4:

Enjoy breakfast at the hotel.

08:30 You will be met by your driver-guide for a **Private Full Day Cape Winelands Tour**.

Get swept away by the overwhelming beauty of rolling vineyards and perfect blue sky. Start off with a visit to Paarl and the spectacular Paarl Valley.

Visit Fairview Wine Estate for Wine Tasting.

The tour continues north-west to the beautiful village of Franschhoek and then on to Stellenbosch, the second oldest town in South Africa and the historic heart of the country's wine region.

Visit Boschendal Wine Farm for wine tasting and lunch.

Enjoy a Romantic Picnic lunch for two.

Return to Cape Town's V & A Waterfront.

Embark on a dinner cruise on board the Alba.

Expect breath-taking views of the Cape Town skyline from our fully glass-enclosed & air-conned restaurant boat, including sights like Table Mountain and the sparkling lights of the V&A Harbor at night on our spellbinding tour through the fishing industry & yacht marina.

Return to your hotel and spend the balance of your evening at leisure.

DAY 5:

Enjoy breakfast at the hotel. Settle your extras account.

Collect your Europcar Group H rental vehicle: RES NR # 323967 (Audi A3 Cabriolet style or similar - ABS Braking System, Airbags, Air-conditioned, 2 Door Vehicle, Manual, Power Steering, Radio/CD & GPS) from our representative who will meet with you in your hotel reception. (Rental is based on Classic Max). Proceed via Self Drive to Knysna.

En-route enjoy a quadbike trail ride at **SA Forest Adventures**.

The route takes about 1 and a half hours to complete and takes guests on a journey through the vineyards of Hamilton Russell and Southern Right wineries. Travel up the mountain into the Fernkloof Nature for the half way stop and spectacular views over the bay.

Drive through the coastal town of Hermanus.

Lunch is served at Lemonicious Restaurant.

Proceed to Knysna (approximately a 5 hour drive). Upon arrival at your hotel check-in.

(Please note that standard check-in time is at 14:00. Early check-in can be requested however it is at the discretion of the hotel and not guaranteed).

Dinner is served at your hotel.

DAY 6:

Enjoy breakfast at the hotel.

Proceed via self-drive to the Tsitsikamma National Park.

Enjoy a bungee jump off The Bloukrans Bridge (weather conditions permitting).

Lunch is served at Tsitsikamma Village Inn.

Return to Knysna.

En-route enjoy a visit to Monkeyland.

Time permitting enjoy some leisure time at the Knysna Lagoon.

Dinner is served at a local Indian restaurant, Raasoie.

Return to your hotel and spend the balance of the evening at leisure.

DAY 7:

Enjoy breakfast at the hotel. Check out and settle your extras account.

Proceed via self-drive to the small town of Oudtshoorn for a Full Day Oudtshoorn Tour.

Oudtshoorn is the ostrich capital of the world. Nowhere else are ostriches found in such great number and nowhere else do they produce feathers of such fine quality – **but the world's biggest bird is just one attraction in an area of enormous contrasts.**

Visit the Cango Caves, internationally renowned as one of the world's great natural wonders, sculpted by nature through the ages. Their fascinating limestone formation occurs in a variety of ways.

Continue on to the Ostrich Ranch and come face to face with the biggest bird in the world.

Lunch is served at the Ostrich Ranch.

Finally, end your day at the Cango Wildlife Ranch. Over 300 crocodiles, ranging from 50 cm to four meters in length, inhabit the ranch. Proceed to your Guest House and check-in on arrival.

Dinner is served at your Guest House.

Spend the balance of your evening at leisure.

DAY 8:

Enjoy breakfast at the hotel and check out.

Proceed via self-drive to George (GRJ) Airport.

On arrival at George (GRJ) Airport, return your Europcar Group H rental vehicle (Audi A3 Cabriolet or similar); to the Europcar rental offices located at the Airport.

Check-in for flight MN 910 to Johannesburg.

Depart George.

Arrive at OR Tambo (JNB) International Airport.

Proceed to the arrivals hall where you will be met by a Royal African Discoveries representative for your private transfer to your lodge.

Upon arrival at the lodge you will be met by the lodge management who will outline the program during your stay as well as the activities available.

Meet your ranger for your afternoon safari game drive (arrival time permitting).

Dinner is served at the lodge.

DAY 9:

After an early morning wake-up call tea and coffee will be served.

Meet your ranger for your morning safari game drive.

Breakfast is served at the lodge.

Spend the day at leisure or enjoy the activities available at the lodge.

Lunch is served at the lodge.

Meet your ranger for your afternoon safari game drive.

Dinner is served at the lodge.
