DAY 1:



Arrive at Cape Town International Airport where you will be met by a royal African Discoveries representative who will assist you to your transfer vehicle.

Meet your driver for your private transfer to the hotel.

Upon arrival at the hotel, check in and spend the balance of the day at leisure.

DAY 2:



Breakfast at the hotel.

Meet your driver for your private transfer to Table Mountain.

Meet your guide and start your hike up to the top of Table Mountain through the Platteklip Gorge. This hiking trail will take you around 2,5 - 3 hours to the top where you will descent via the Cable car.

Proceed to the Victorian and Alfred waterfront.

Take an aerial view of Cape Town with a beautiful Table Mountain backdrop out of a helicopter. This 15 minute flights will surely put the beauty of the mother city into perspective.

Spend the rest of the afternoon in the waterfront where the following activities can be arranged.

- Sunset cruise.
- Shopping.
- Cape wheel.
- Jet boating

Return to the hotel in the late evening.

DAY 3:



Meet your driver-guide in the reception area of the hotel for you Full-day Hermanus tour.
Approximately a 2 hours drive from Cape Town.

Early morning departure from the hotel. (Collect your breakfast pack in the reception).

You will embark on a Shark cage diving experience for the opportunity to see a Great white shark in its natural habitat. This excursion is based in Gansbaai not far from Hermanus and will take around 3 hours.

Back on dry land your driver will take you to your next adrenalin fill adventure.

The **Quad Bike Trail** in Hermanus is a must as it is rated as one of the top trails in South Africa. This route takes you through the world-renowned vineyards of Hamilton Russell and Southern Right wineries. Travel up the mountain and through the fynbos kingdom into the Fernkloof Nature Reserve. Your half way point is one of the most pristine look-out points in the Western Cape. From here you will have a spectacular birds-eye-view of Hermanus and Walkerbay. Cameras on this trip are an absolute must! – Whale spotting from this vantage point allows you to see the bigger picture of activity throughout the entire bay.

Continue to the town of Hermanus to spend some time at leisure before heading back to the hotel In Cape Town.

Upon arrival at the hotel spend the balance of the day at leisure.

DAY 4:



Breakfast at the hotel. You will be met by your driver-guide for your private full day Cape Point tour.

The Cape Of Good hope nature reserve *Cape Point*, a World Heritage Site, and protected Nature Reserve is an area of vast natural beauty, world renown for its natural vegetation and rich bio-diversity. A short hike to the famous light house at Cape Point will provide you with breath-taking views of the Atlantic ocean and False bay.

Head back to Cape Town via the Chapman's peak drive to your Zipline adventure.

The adventure begins with a brief safety introduction at our office with in the Silvermist Estate. From here guests will embark on a hair raising guided 4 x 4 drive into the mountain high above Constantia with a spectacular view of Cape Town. Cape Town Ziplines boarders on the Table Mountain National Park Reserve. You will be surrounded by the natural beauty, fauna and flora while walking and zipline between the 12 platforms. You could almost mistakably think that you are inside the Table Mountain Nature Reserve as you take in the amazing scenery.

The Zipline experience offers you a tour of the cables starting high in the mountain and slowly descending down the slopes. Our platforms offer visitors the most amazing panoramic views of Cape Town. Guides on the tour will assist with your extreme journey and ensure you have a memorable experience. Some of our Ziplines are as high as 155 Meters with the tree top canopy below and the longest of the Ziplines in the tour is just under 500 meters. End your day at the Kirstenbosch botanical Gardens.

The beautiful Kirstenbosch Gardens cover an area of 528 hectares with 36 hectares of cultivated garden. The gardens are a celebration of South African flora - showcasing only indigenous South African plants. Fynbos, proteas, cycads and rolling lawns are intermingled with streams and ponds and well-laid out pathways for easy walking. A great variety of birds inhabit the gardens and the sweeping views from the upper slopes are spectacular. The Treetop Canopy Walkway gives visitors the opportunity to experience the forest from high above the ground. The galvanised steel structure meanders through trees and branches, with sections that crown above the forest.

Return to the hotel in the afternoon and spend the balance of the day at leisure.

DAY 5:



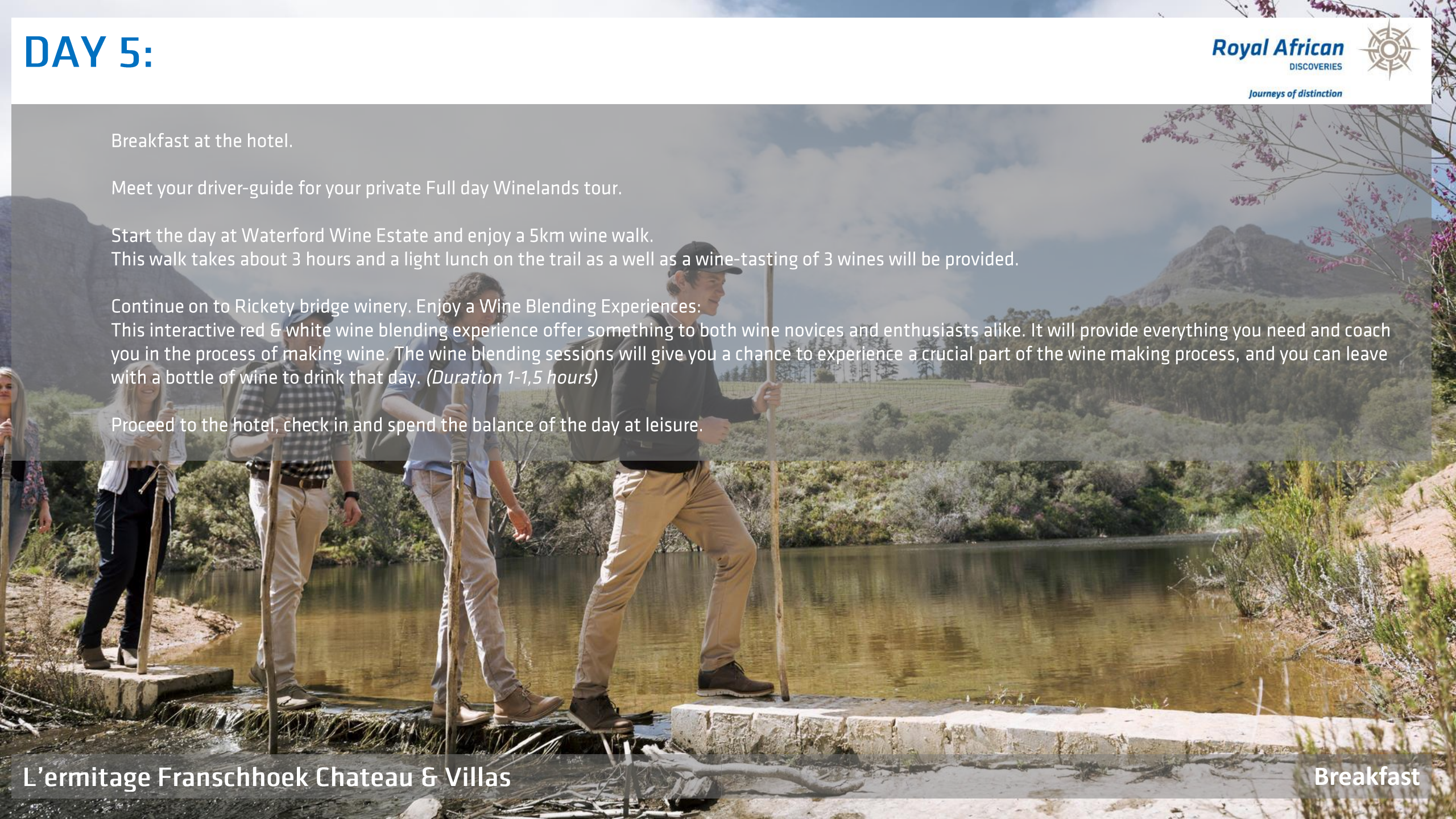
Breakfast at the hotel.

Meet your driver-guide for your private Full day Winelands tour.

Start the day at Waterford Wine Estate and enjoy a 5km wine walk. This walk takes about 3 hours and a light lunch on the trail as well as a wine-tasting of 3 wines will be provided.

Continue on to Rickety bridge winery. Enjoy a Wine Blending Experiences: This interactive red & white wine blending experience offer something to both wine novices and enthusiasts alike. It will provide everything you need and coach you in the process of making wine. The wine blending sessions will give you a chance to experience a crucial part of the wine making process, and you can leave with a bottle of wine to drink that day. *(Duration 1-1,5 hours)*

Proceed to the hotel, check in and spend the balance of the day at leisure.



DAY 6:



Breakfast at the hotel.

Meet your driver for your private transfer to the hotel.

The Franschhoek Wine Tram hop-on hop-off tour is one of the best ways to discover the true essence of the Franschhoek Valley – picturesque vineyards, breath-taking scenery, warm hospitality, world-class cuisine, fine wines and a 300-year history.

Passengers aboard the hop-on hop-off tour will experience a unique and leisurely way to see the Franschhoek Valley as they journey through rolling vineyards in a vintage style railway tram and open-air tram-bus stopping in at some of South Africa's oldest and most distinguished wine estates.

A combination of tram and tram-bus transports passengers around a loop of stops allowing them to hop-off at each stop and experience the activities on offer, be it wine tasting, a cellar tour, lunch or simply a stroll through the vineyards and when they are ready, hop-on to continue the tour.

The tour takes passengers right into the heart of the Franschhoek Valley, with a narration focusing on the history of Franschhoek and wine cultivation in the valley and unparalleled views of the valley and vineyards.

Full day experience visiting a maximum of 5 wine farms.

Return to the hotel in the afternoon and spend the balance of the day at leisure.

DAY 7:



Breakfast at the hotel

you will be met by your driver for your private transfer to Cape Town International Airport.

Arrive at Cape Town International Airport and check in for your flight to Victoria Falls.

Arrive at Victoria Falls International Airport where you will be met by your driver for your Seat-in-Coach transfer to the hotel.

Upon arrival at the hotel, check in and spend the balance of the day at leisure.

DAY 8:



Breakfast at the hotel.

You will be met by your driver-guide in the hotel reception and depart on your Seat-in-Coach Tour of the Falls.

Transfer to start your tour to discover how the Victoria Falls were formed and what local customs and traditions surround them. The Victoria Falls is the largest, probably the most beautiful and certainly the most majestic waterfall anywhere in the world.

Return to the hotel.

You will be met by your driver-guide in the hotel reception and depart to the helipad for your 12 minute scheduled flight (weather conditions permitting) over the falls. The “Flight of Angels” is an amazing journey over the 1700m vast curtain of water known locally as the “Mosi oa Tunya” (the smoke that thunders) and along the Zambezi River and the Zambezi National Park. Passengers are treated to an unforgettable helicopter journey comprising of 4 circuits (2 on either side) offering unrivalled spectacular views, photographic, and filming opportunities and putting the full breadth and height of The Falls into glorious perspective within the surrounding environment.

Return to the hotel and spend the balance of the day at leisure.

DAY 9:



You will be met at the hotel for your Full day seta-in-coach trip to Chobe.

The tour departs daily from Victoria Falls where guests are transferred by road for 70km to the border where their Botswana guide will meet them after immigration procedures. A full day Safari package that include a cruise on the Chobe river and a Game drive in the world-famous Chobe National Park. The Chobe National park in Botswana is home to one of the largest game concentrations in Africa. Bordered by the banks of the breath-taking Chobe River, it is famous for its rich elephant and lion population.

Return to the hotel in Zimbabwe in the late afternoon.

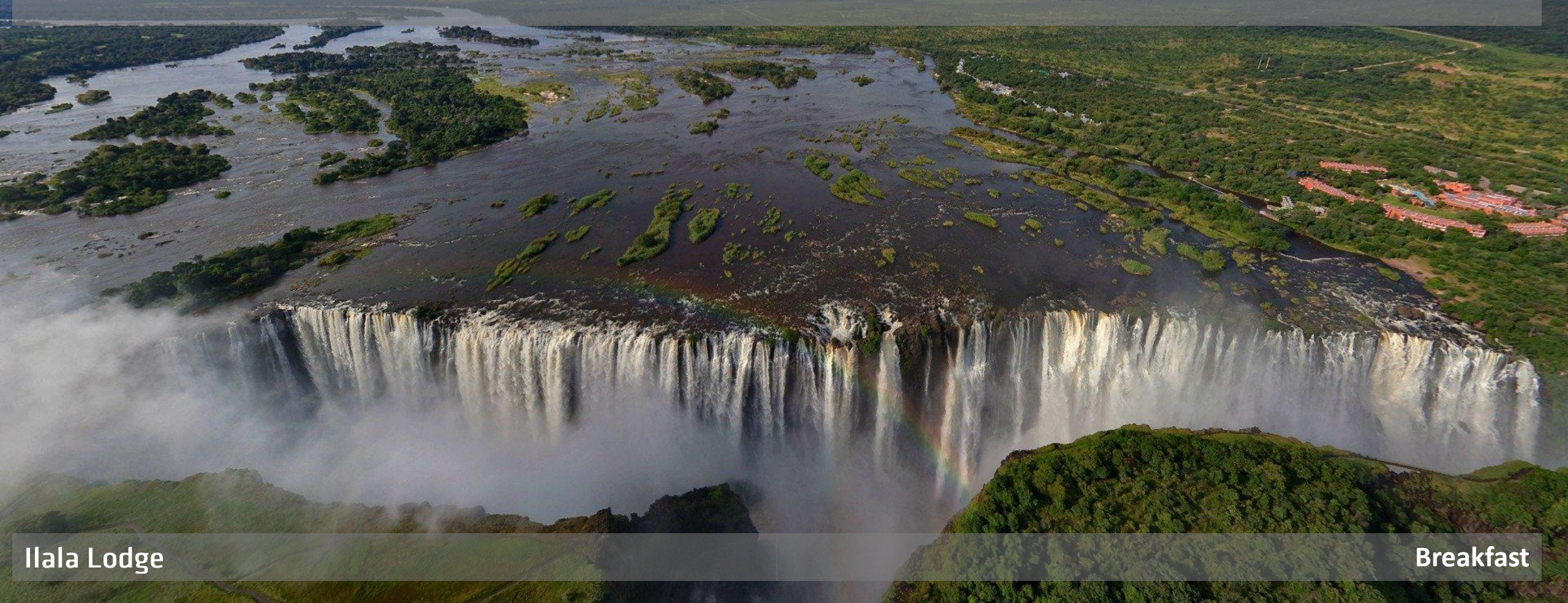
