DAY 1:

Arrive at OR Tambo (Johannesburg) International Airport, where you will be met by a Royal African Discoveries representative who will assist you to connect with your scheduled charter flight directly to Jackalberry Airstrip.

Upon arrival at Jackalberry Airstrip, you will be met by Royal Malewane representative for your short transfer to Royal Malewane The Farmstead.

Lunch is served at the lodge upon arrival (arrival time permitting)

Afternoon game drive which may continue into the early evening in order to view the nocturnal animals as well.

Dinner is served at the lodge.

The Farmhouse at The Farmstead is a three and a half bedroom private villa. The Farmhouse has its own private services including a chef, housekeeper, butler, private safari vehicle, ranger and tracker. There are three main bedrooms as well as a smaller children's room. There is a magnificent deck with a large swimming pool flowing out into the bush. Children of all ages are welcome in the Farmhouse.

DAY 2 & 3:

After tea, coffee and snacks your ranger will escorts you to his open safari vehicle for your morning game drive.

Return to the lodge and enjoy breakfast.

Spend the day at leisure.

Lunch is served at the lodge.

Afternoon game drive that continues into the evening.

Dinner is served at the lodge.



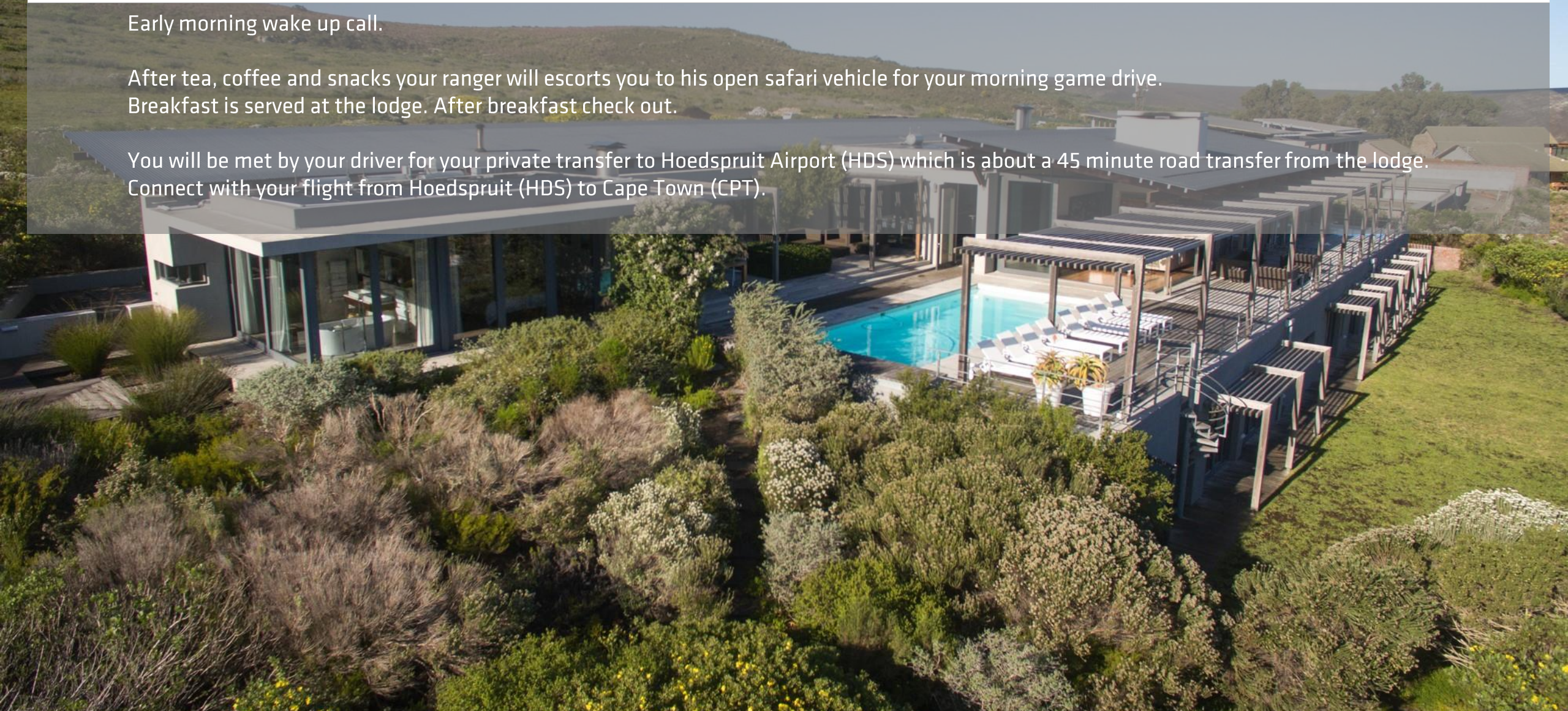
DAY 4:



Early morning wake up call.

After tea, coffee and snacks your ranger will escorts you to his open safari vehicle for your morning game drive. Breakfast is served at the lodge. After breakfast check out.

You will be met by your driver for your private transfer to Hoedspruit Airport (HDS) which is about a 45 minute road transfer from the lodge. Connect with your flight from Hoedspruit (HDS) to Cape Town (CPT).



DAY 4 (continues):



Arrive at Cape Town International Airport, where you will be met by a Royal African Discoveries representative who will assist you to your transfer. You will be met by your driver-guide for a private transfer to the Grootbos Private Nature Reserve. This will be about a 2 ½ hour road transfer.

Enjoy a welcome drink upon arrival at Grootbos Private Nature Reserve. Light lunch is served at the lodge (arrival time permitting). A guide will outline the program during your stay as well as the activities available. Settle in or enjoy an afternoon activity. Spend the balance of the day at leisure before making your way to the main lodge for dinner.

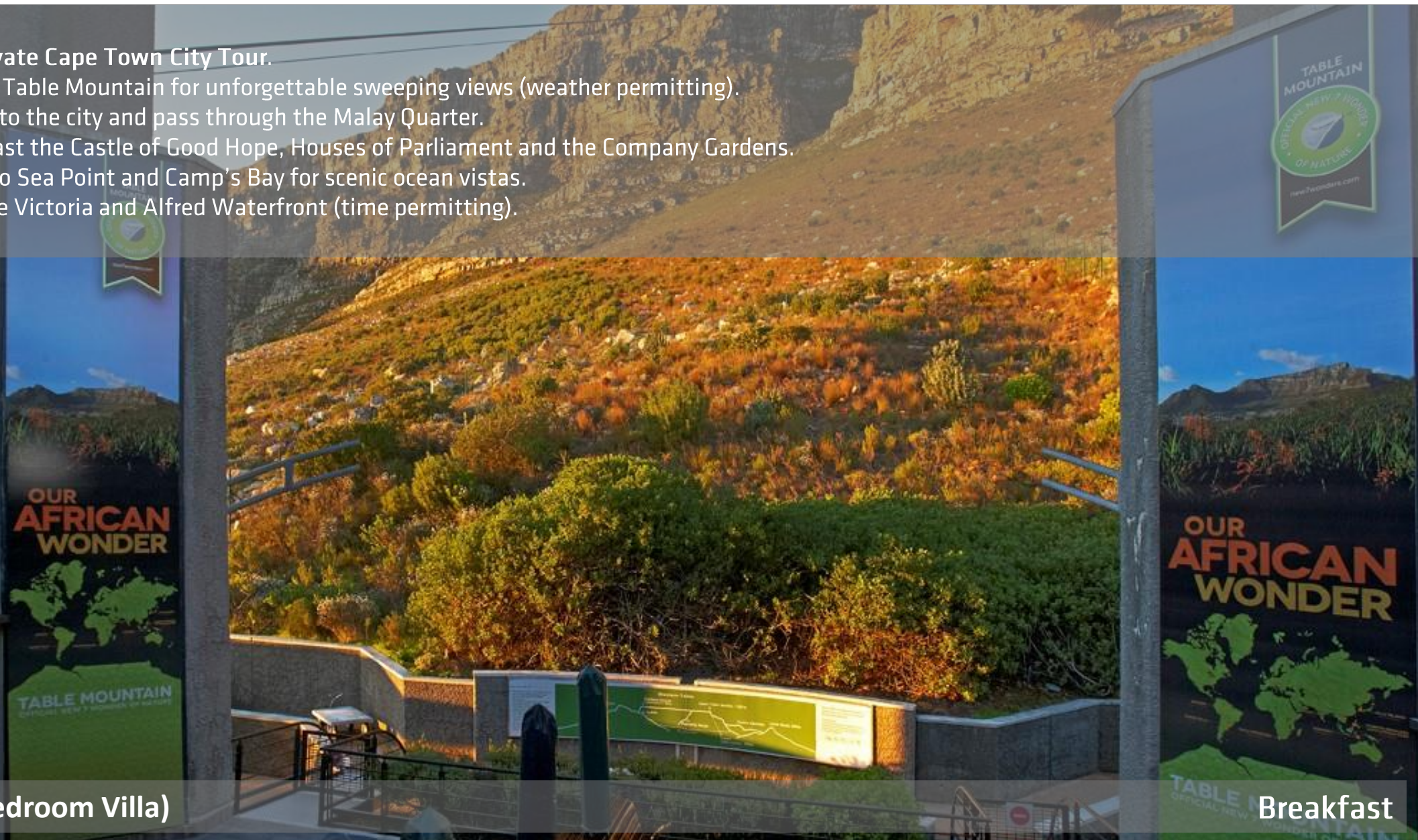
- Depart from the V&A Waterfront, fly over the city bowl, Green Point Stadium, Clifton Beach, Camps Bay and The Twelve Apostles.
- Also enjoy spectacular views of Llandudno, Hout Bay and Seal Island. Continue on for views of Chapman's Peak, Noordehoek, Kommetjie, Scarborough and Cape Point.
- Return over Fals Bay, Simonstown, Fish Hoek and Muizenberg before landing at the V&A Waterfront.

DAY 8 (continues):



Enjoy a Private Cape Town City Tour.

- Ascend Table Mountain for unforgettable sweeping views (weather permitting).
- Return to the city and pass through the Malay Quarter.
- Drive past the Castle of Good Hope, Houses of Parliament and the Company Gardens.
- Travel to Sea Point and Camp's Bay for scenic ocean vistas.
- Visit the Victoria and Alfred Waterfront (time permitting).



DAY 9:



Breakfast at the hotel.

You will be met by your driver-guide. The vehicle with driver-guide will be at our disposal for the entire day including dinner transfers.

Enjoy a **Private Full Day Cape Peninsula Tour**. Travel at a pace that allows you to explore the beauty of the Cape Peninsula.

Depart for the Cape of Good Hope Nature Reserve along one of South Africa's most scenic routes, passing Hout Bay.

Enjoy a cruise to Seal Island, to view seals and sea birds at Duiker Island (weather permitting). During summer, several thousand Cape Fur Seals – along with the rare Black Cormorant – lollop leisurely among the kelp beds.

Travel along Chapman's Peak Drive (conditions permitting).



DAY 9 (continues):

Continue to the Cape of Good Hope Nature Reserve.

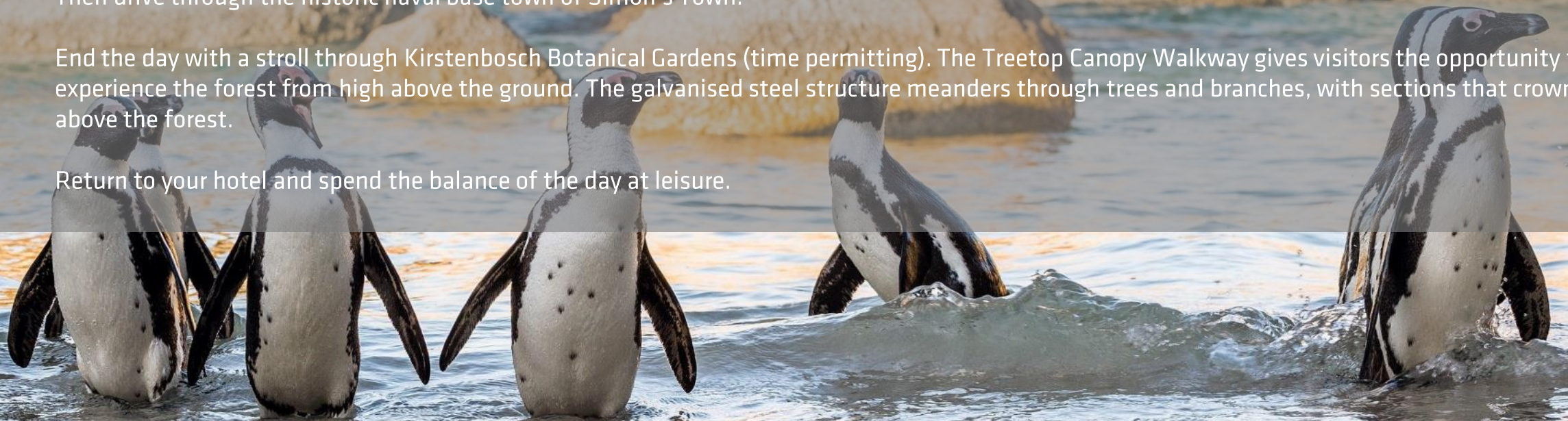
The scenery en route to Cape Point, at the South Western tip of the reserve, is particularly lovely in spring when wildflowers carpet the landscape. The new lighthouse – the most powerful in the world – beams an electric light of 19 million candle power across the ocean. Ascend to the top of by The Flying Dutchman funicular.

Visit the penguin colony at Boulders Beach.

Then drive through the historic naval base town of Simon's Town.

End the day with a stroll through Kirstenbosch Botanical Gardens (time permitting). The Treetop Canopy Walkway gives visitors the opportunity to experience the forest from high above the ground. The galvanised steel structure meanders through trees and branches, with sections that crown above the forest.

Return to your hotel and spend the balance of the day at leisure.



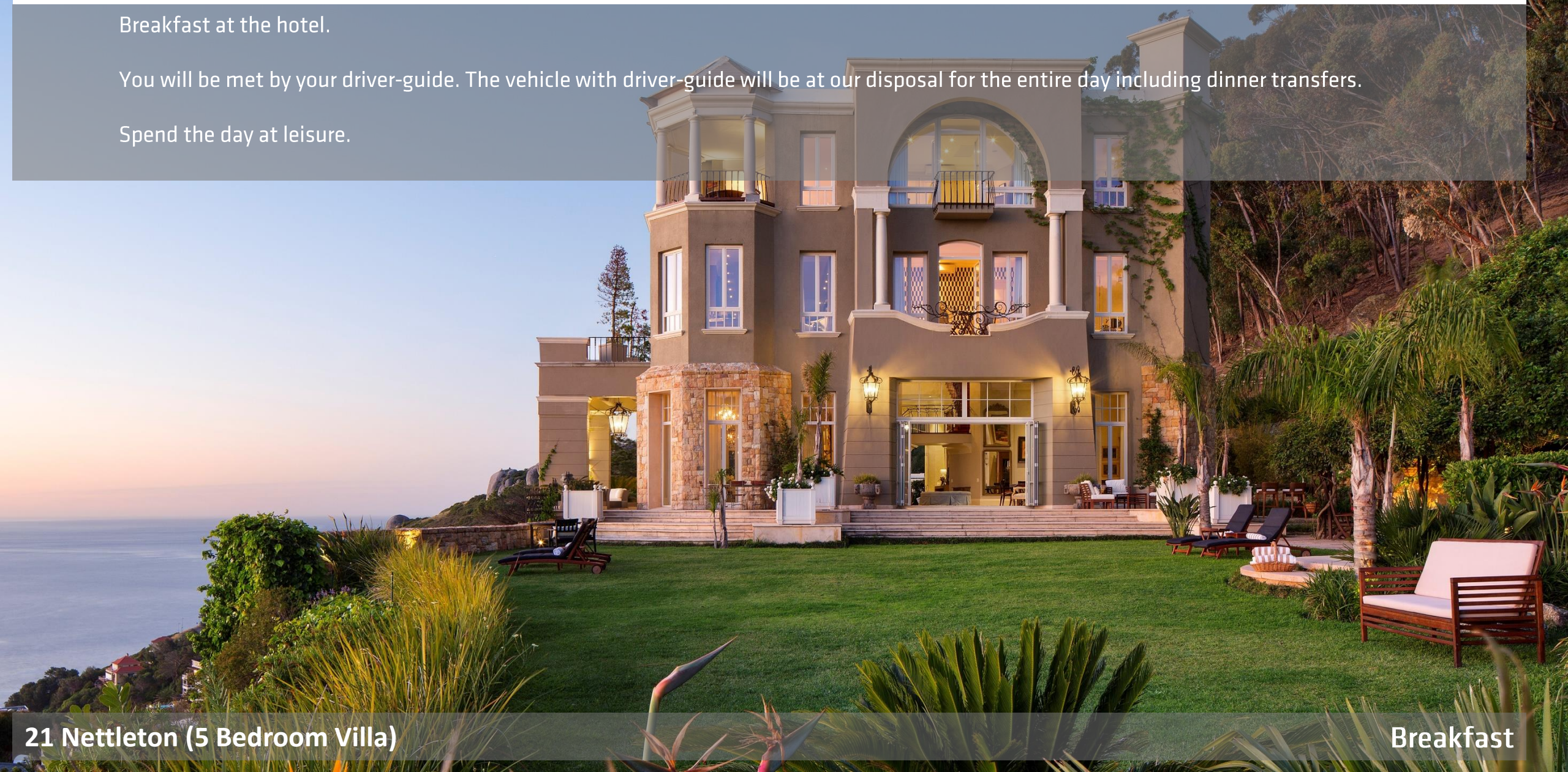
DAY 10:

You will be met by your driver-guide. The vehicle with driver-guide will be at our disposal for the entire day including dinner transfers.

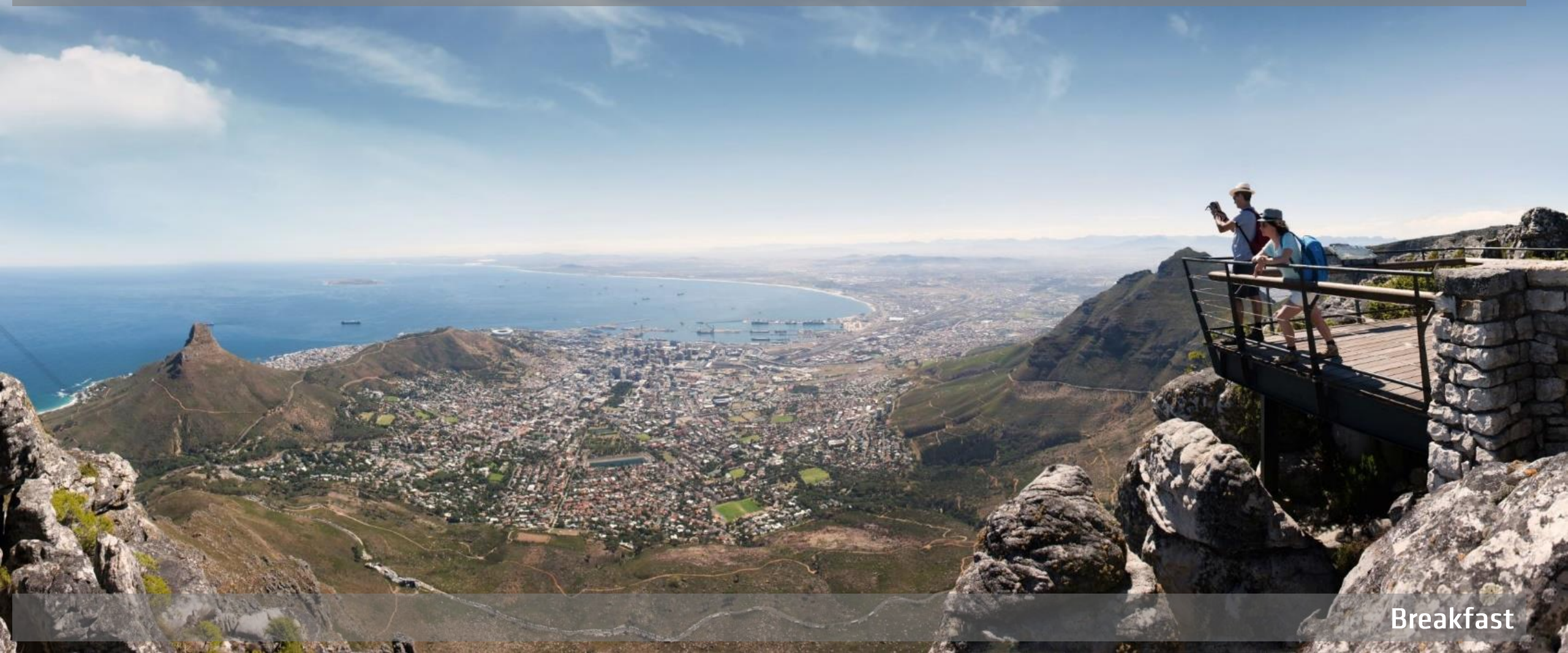
